Happy New Year! I am excited to be a partner in ministry with you here at Immanuel. I thought you might like to know a little bit about me as we begin our transition time together.

I was born and lived most of my childhood in the LA basin of California. We moved around a lot to follow Dad's need to find better and better jobs to support our family of six. My family was infrequently in church, but all I remember about churches was good. I was confirmed and received my first communion in a congregation of the Augustana Synod (later LCA, then ELCA) but in high school and college I attended Missouri Synod churches.

I was trained as a church school teacher and have been a volunteer church leader in many areas: youth group leader, adult and youth Bible study leader, Sunday School teacher and daily classroom teacher. Also, unrelated to this purpose, I have served on congregation councils, been Financial Secretary, created, directed and published children's Christmas programs, sung in choirs and led drives to assist the needy.

Following 15 years of classroom teaching that spanned all ages and ability levels, I enrolled at Wartburg Theological Seminary at Dubuque, Iowa. There, I earned my Master of Divinity degree in 1993. My first call to ordained parish ministry was at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church (ELCA) in Stafford Springs, CT. While there, I also served as the Bishop's Assistant/Secretary of the Slovak Zion Synod of the ELCA and a part-time chaplain at a state home for people with developmental disabilities. I served six years as a member of the Board for Higher Education and Schools of the ELCA beginning in that call and continuing into the next.

My second call was to serve Holy Trinity Lutheran Church (ELCA) at Trumbull, CT. I also served as Co-chair of the Bridge Building Ministry of the Council of Churches of Greater Bridgeport. I received the Distinguished Service Award from the Council of Churches for 12 years volunteering in various capacities. During my tenure at Trumbull, the membership of the congregation grew from 220 to over 300 baptized souls.

Throughout my ministry, I have enjoyed writing petitions to be used as the Prayers of the Church (or Prayers of the People). About 15 years ago, while sharing some of my petitions online with friends and colleagues, I was encouraged to make these writings more widely available. Friends began telling friends about my prayers and people started requesting my prayers weekly. Last year, readers of *The Lutheran Forum* magazine were invited by the editor to contact me about receiving the prayers for their own use. This referral has resulted in the need to send additional emails each week.

During my ten months at Grace in Naugatuck, ending on Labor Day this year, I helped the congregation transition from one called pastor to the next. Some of the things we accomplished together there were improved communication, accurate record keeping and improvement in the timely processing of bills and invoices, and establishing an accurate membership roster. My schedule was half time and hours were flexible while I did maintain regular office hours for availability. $\rightarrow \rightarrow \rightarrow$
